## Mexican Lasagna

- 2 lbs. Ground beef
- 1 can (16 oz) refried beans
- 1 can (4 oz) chopped green chilies
- 1 envelope taco seasoning
- 2 Tbsp hot salsa
- 12 oz uncooked lasagna noodles
- 4 cups (16 oz) shredded Colby-Monterey Jack cheese
- 1 jar (16 oz) mild salsa
- 2 cups water
- 2 cups sour cream
- 1 can (2-1/4 oz) sliced ripe olives, drained
- 3 green onions, chopped

In large skillet, cook beef over medium heat until no longer pink; drain. Stir in the beans, chilies, taco seasoning and hot salsa. In greased 13x9x2-inch baking dish, layer a third

of the noodles and meat mixture. Sprinkle 1 cup of the cheese. Repeat layers twice. Combine mild salsa and water; pour over top. Cover and bake at 350° for 1 hour or until heated through. Top with sour cream, olives, onions and remaining cheese. Bake uncovered to 5 minutes longer. Let stand 10-15 min before cutting. 12 servings.



## Potato and Corn Chowder

- 2 T butter
- 1 large onion, finely chopped
- 2 celery ribs, chopped
- 3 (14-oz.) cans of chicken broth
- 1 1/2 cups frozen or canned corn
- 2 large potatoes, peeled and diced
- 1/2 t salt
- 1 cup heavy cream or half-and-half
- 2 T all-purpose flour
- Pepper to taste

Melt butter in a large saucepan. Stir in onion and celery. Cook 9-10 minutes or until tender. Add the chicken broth, corn, potatoes and salt. Lower the heat and cover the pan. Simmer for about 10 minutes

or until the potatoes are tender. In a small bowl, whisk the flour and cream and add to the potato mixture; simmer about 8 minutes. Serve with grated cheese and crumbled bacon.

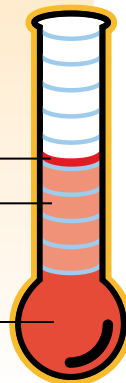

Tips to help you save \$ and energy

**Save money and energy by implementing these no-cost efficiency measures:**

- ▶ Turn off lights when rooms are not occupied.
- ▶ Tap winter daylight by leaving window blinds open.
- ▶ Disconnect unnecessary or unused equipment.
- ▶ Turn thermostat down to lowest setting comfortable when wearing a sweater.



**Safety Tip**

**Portable heaters can efficiently heat one room at a time, but they need to be used with care.**

- ▶ Always read and follow the operator's manual.
- ▶ Never use portable heaters near water, like in a bathroom or a damp basement.
- ▶ Never touch a portable heater if you are wet or if your hands are wet. This can result in electric shock.
- ▶ Always unplug portable heaters when they are not in use and allow for your portable heater to have its own electrical outlet so electrical overload does not occur.
- ▶ Keep children or pets away from portable heaters.
- ▶ Always place portable heaters at least 3 feet away from objects such as furniture, beds or drapes.
