General Service Rate Information
Single-Phase Curtailable Service—RATE 5
Rates Effective as of November 1, 2008

At the discretion of the co-op, this option may be available to General Service members. During certain peak demand periods, the co-op may request that the member switch on their generation equipment or otherwise curtail their demand. In return the member receives a demand discount. A written agreement is required for this service.

Curtailed Demand for any calendar month is the difference between the member's fifteen-minute demand immediately preceding the co-op's request for load control and the member's maximum fifteen-minute demand within any clock hour of the requested load control period. Demand Discount will apply only in months where the co-op requests load control.

The co-op provides a load control switch to signal the member when a curtailment period begins and ends. Upon receiving a starting signal the member has the option of which loads, if any, and how much load they wish to curtail.

*** Minimum Monthly Charge:**

For services requiring transformer capacity in excess of 50 kVA, the minimum monthly charge will be increased \$1.50 per kVA or fraction thereof.

Minimum Annual Charge:

This service is available for continuous year-round electric service for a minimum term of twelve months. Members requesting reconnection after being disconnected for less than twelve months shall be responsible for paying the greater of the monthly minimum or the Basic Facilities Charge times the number of months the service was disconnected.

**** Billing Demand:**

The Billing Demand shall be the maximum registered or computed kW during any 15-minute interval within the current billing month.

Wholesale Power Cost Adjustment (WPCA)

Energy charges may be adjusted to recover changes in the costs of wholesale purchased power. Upon approval by the Board of Directors, the energy charges may also be adjusted to maintain the financial integrity of the Cooperative.

Terms of Payment:

The bill is due upon receipt. If not paid within 15 days from the date of the bill, the Cooperative will use collection procedures as provided in the Rules and Regulations.
