LOCAL STUDENT HONORED AT WOLFPACK WOMEN'S BASKETBALL GAME FOR RECEIVING BASKETBALL CAMP SCHOLARSHIP

SUPPLY, N.C. (FEB. 16, 2018) – A local middle-school student was honored during a recent N.C. State University women's basketball game on Sunday, Feb. 11 for winning a Touchstone Energy Sports Camp Scholarship to attend the Wolfpack Women's Basketball Camp last summer.

Morgan Bellamy, daughter of Levi and Darrilyn Bellamy of Shallotte, was recognized at half court during the Wolfpack Women's basketball game against UNC for earning a scholarship from Brunswick Electric Membership Corporation.
